*Sugar Craft **

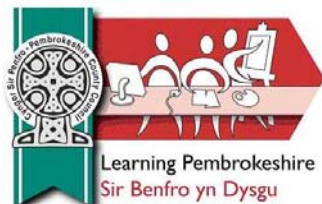

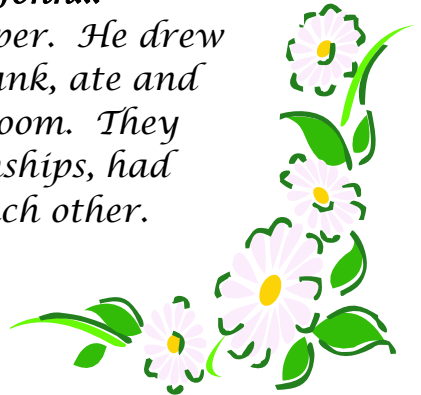
